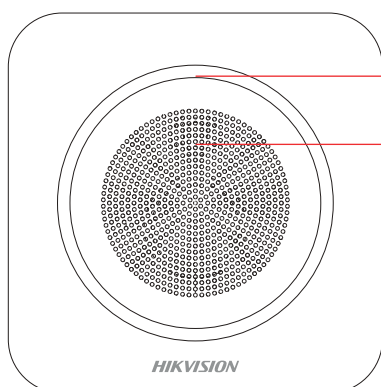

Keep upward according to the arrow on the rear panel when moving or using the equipment.



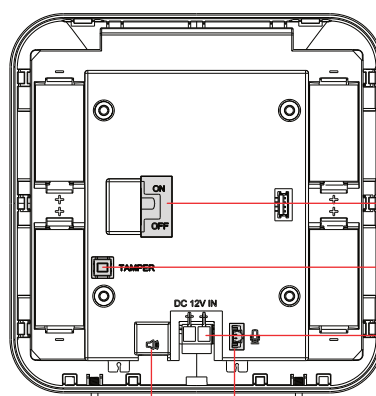

2 Set Up

1. Set up with APP.

● Preparation

Log in to the APP Store, download and install the App.

Power on the security control panel.

Log in the APP and tap the icon "+". Scan the QR code or input the control panel serial No. to add the control panel.

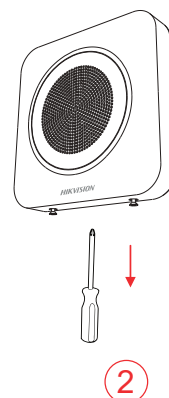
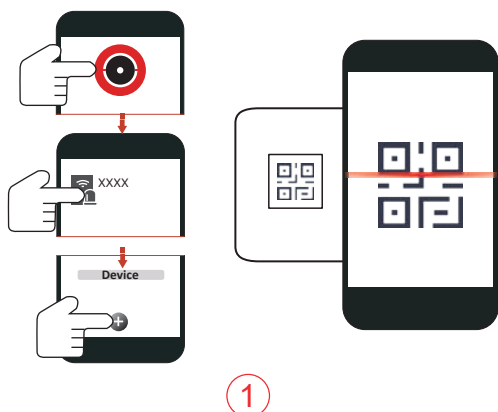
① Enroll the Peripheral Locally

In the APP, tap the "Enrollment Mode" button on the control panel page to make the control panel enter the enrollment status.

② Enroll the Peripheral with QR and serial No.

In the APP, tap the icon "+" and scan the QR code or serial No. on the peripheral.

2. Loosen the screw and open the shell.



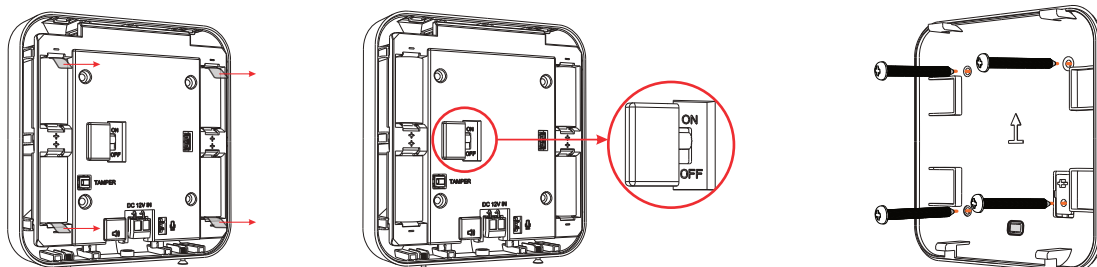
3. Power on and install the rear panel.

① Battery Powered

(1) Remove the battery insulator.

(2) Turn on the power switch.

(3) Install the rear panel on the wall with four supplied screws.



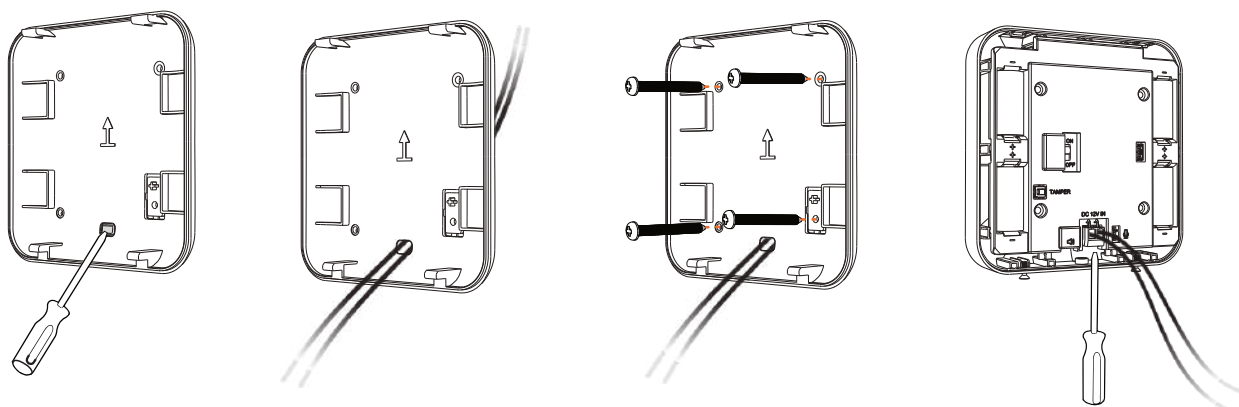
② DC12 V Powered

(1) Knock out the wiring hole.

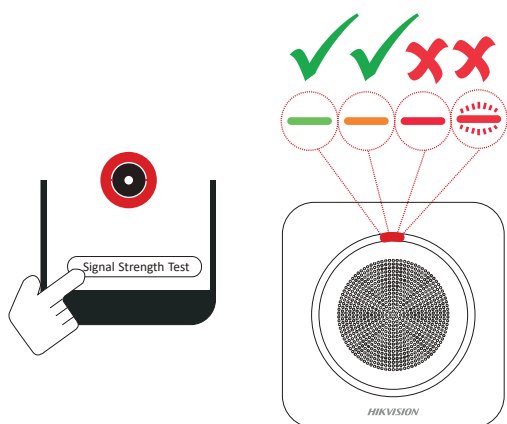
(2) Thread the cables through the wiring hole.

(3) Install the rear panel on the wall with four supplied screws.

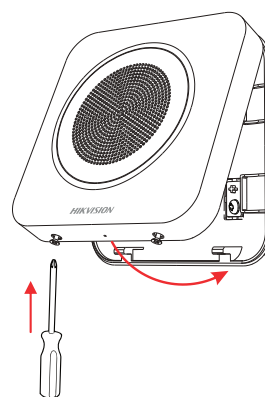
(4) Connect the cables to the DC12 V holder, and turn on the power switch.



4. Check Signal Strength
 - Solid Green for 3 s - Strong Signal
 - Solid Orange for 3 s - Medium Signal
 - Solid Red for 3 s - Weak Signal
 - Flash Red for 6 times - Lost Signal
5. Close the shell and tighten the screw.

3 Set Up with App

You can view the device status including temperature, signal intensity, battery level, lid, external input, etc., on the device page. Tap the  button to enter the settings page.

4 Operation Caution and Device Maintenance

- All the electronic operation should be strictly compliance with the electrical safety regulations, fire prevention regulations and other related regulations in your local region.

 - If smoke, odors or noise rise from the device, turn off the power at once and unplug the power cable, and then please contact the service center.
 - Do not drop the device or subject it to physical shock, and do not expose it to high electromagnetism radiation. Avoid the equipment installation on vibrations surface or places subject to shock (ignorance can cause equipment damage).
 - Do not place the device in extremely hot (refer to the specification of the device for the detailed operation temperature), cold, dusty or damp locations, and do not expose it to high electromagnetic radiation.
 - The device for indoor use shall be kept from rain and moisture.
- Exposing the equipment to direct sun light, low ventilation or heat source such as heater or radiator is forbidden (ignorance can cause fire danger).
- Do not aim the device at the sun or extra bright places. A blooming or smear may occur otherwise (which is not a malfunction however), and affecting the endurance of sensor at the same time.
